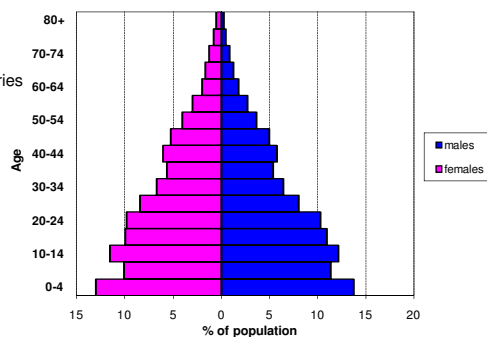

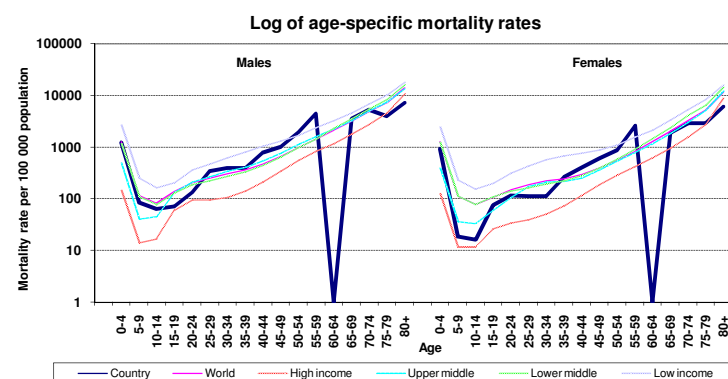

Population pyramid

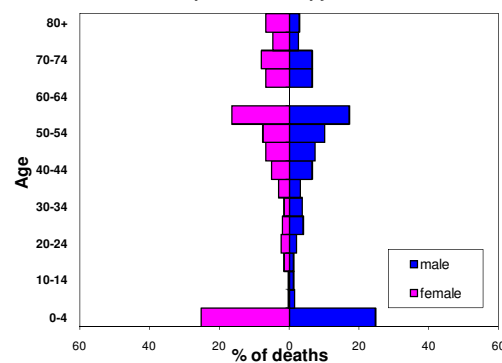

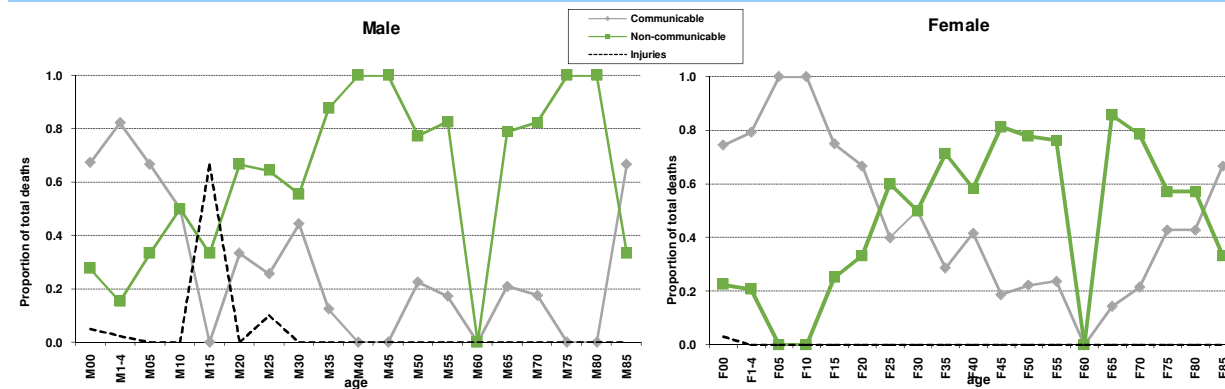
Age- and sex-specific death rates
