



Influenza Like Illnesses Outbreak Situational Report

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OVERVIEW

ILI cases are still on going. Acute Fever & rash are also included in the line listing.
- ILI type A has been found by the Laboratory department
- Contact Tracing had been done by EH department: 7 AFR cases; 5 cases referred to Laboratory and **1 Positive case** of Chikungunya 24 male from Taborio was found.

CASE DEFINITION

- Influenza Like Illnesses:** Sudden onset of *fever*, with either cough or sore throat.
- Acute Fever & Rash:** Person of any age who presents with *acute fever illness* with acute *non-vesicular rash*
- Chikungunya:** *Acute onset of fever* >38.5°C AND severe *arthralgia/arthritis* not explained by other medical conditions AND residing in or having visited epidemic areas, having reported transmission within 15 days prior to the onset of symptoms.

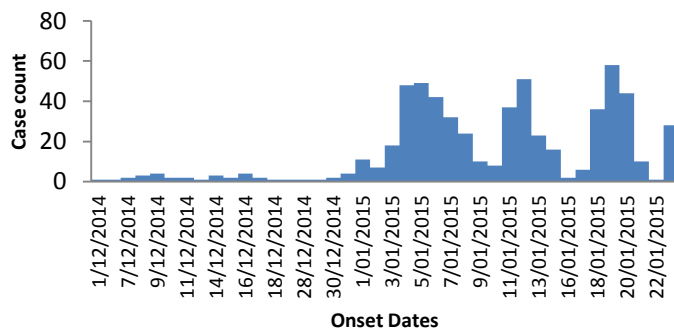
